



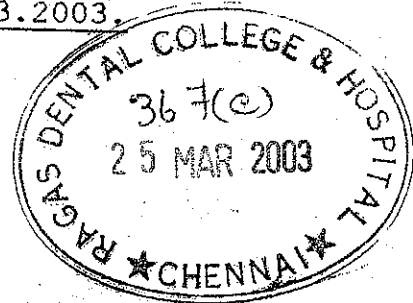

I am directed to state that in the Government letter first cited permission was granted to the Ragas Educational Society to increase the intake I year BDS Course from 60 to 100. In the reference 2nd cited, the above Society has requested the Government to revalidate the orders issued in the Government letter first cited. The Director of Medical Education, after making an Inspection has now recommended for the increase of seats in I year BDS Course in Ragas Dental College from 60 to 100.

2. I am directed to state that the Government, after verifying the desirability and feasibility, convey the permission/Essentiality Certificate to increase the intake capacity of BDS students at Ragas Dental College and Hospital, Chennai from 60(sixty) to 100(One hundred only) subject to the condition that the approval of Government of India / Dental
