## NSS REGULAR CAMP REPORT 2018-2019

**18<sup>th</sup> April' 2018**

World Health Day was celebrated at the college campus. "The theme and slogan of World Health Day 2019 is universal health coverage : everyone, everywhere. The slogan is "Health for All". Around 80 NSS volunteers participated in the program.

**16<sup>th</sup> May' 2018**

No Tobacco Day celebration- A rally was organized for the students in Uthandi and Kanathur areas for increasing awareness regarding ill effects of tobacco. The focus of world No Tobacco Day 2019 is on "TOBACCO AND LUNG HEALTH". The campaign increased the awareness on the negative impact that tobacco has on peoples lung health, from cancer to chronic respiratory disease, the fundamental role lung plays for the health and well being of all people. Around 100 NSS participants actively participated in the rally.

**13<sup>th</sup> June' 2018**

World environmental day- Plant sapling plantation programme and orientation lecture for the students to increase the awareness about eco friendly practice was held in the college premises. Every year environment day is celebrated on 5<sup>th</sup> June to spread awareness, to encourage people to take action and to protect the environment.

Career guidance program was organized in the college auditorium for the students doing internship. The programme developed individual's competencies in self knowledge, educational and occupational exploration, and career planning. **13<sup>th</sup> February' 2019**


We conducted dental screening and treatment camp at Kelambakkam government high school along with the NSS special camp conducted by Jaya engineering college.

We conducted dental screening and dental treatment camp at Panaiyur government high school along with NSS special camp conducted by Sakthi engineering college.


**20<sup>th</sup> March' 2019**

## NSS SPECIAL CAMP REPORT 2018-2019

**THEME:** TOBACCO FREE ENVIRONMENT

**DATE:** 21.01.2019 – 28.01.2019

**VENUE:** Kanathur

The NSS unit of Ragas Dental College & Hospital, along with The Jaya trust management and The Principal, Ragas Dental College & Hospital conducted a special camp for a period of 7 days from 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2019 to 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 in Kanathur Village, Kanchipuram.

The program was conducted under the guidance of **Prof.Kanagaraj**, Chairman, Jaya group of Institutions, **Prof.Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan**, M.D.S., Principal, Ragas Dental College & Hospital and **Dr.P.D.Madan Kumar**, M.D.S., Prof. & Head, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital.

**Prof.Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan**, M.D.S., Principal, Ragas Dental College & Hospital inaugurated the program and **Mrs.S.Kalaiarasi**, M.A., M.Ed., M.Phil, Headmistress of the panchayat union middle school presided over the function.

Inaugural speech was delivered by **Prof.Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan**, M.D.S., Principal, Ragas Dental College & Hospital. His speech motivated and stimulated the NSS volunteers about communication and social interaction towards the public, to gather information about the social issues among the community members.

Presidential address was given by **Dr.P.D.Madan Kumar**, M.D.S., Prof. & Head, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital. The speech delivered by him to the NSS volunteers highlighted about their role and importance in conducting such special camps in the village for the betterment of the locals and the school children.

The chief guest **Mr.K.Narasimman**, B.E., being a local person and past panchayat union chairman of the village, was so happy for selecting their village to be a part of such a useful community program. This campaign was useful for all the community members in aspects of medical/dental camps, healthy talk forums, etc.

The headmistress of the school **Mrs.S.Kalaiarasi**, M.A., M.Ed., M.Phil appreciated about the use of school health program and dental camp among school children and for the village people.

The NSS volunteers of the Ragas Dental College & Hospital organized a skit play on "**Tobacco-The Demon**" which insists the harmful and hazardous effects of tobacco, both in smoking and smokeless forms and highlighted the effects of passive smoking. Nearly 100 public were involved in this program.

The day ended with the scavenging of the village and school premises and pamphlets were issued related to the theme and activities to be performed by the NSS volunteers in the forthcoming days.



**22.01.2019, TUESDAY**

**GENERAL MEDICINE CAMP**

The medical camp was conducted by the Ragas general hospital which is situated in the premises of Ragas dental college & hospital. Free medical checkup was done to the public for various ailments including hypertension, diabetes mellitus, anemia, gastritis, vomiting, abdominal pain. The NSS volunteers actively participated in the program by checking blood pressure, temperature and weight of the participants. Nearly 150 people were benefitted by this medical camp.

**23.01.2019, WEDNESDAY**

**DENTAL CAMP**

The dental camp was conducted on 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2019 which was a screening and treatment program. Along with NSS volunteers, 30 students who were on their internship, also actively participated in the program. The camp was conducted in the school premises. All the school children and the village public who attended the camp were screened for any dental problems.

After the initial screening, those who were in need of dental treatment were identified and treatments like simple extraction, scaling, restoration were done. Those who are need of any kind of advanced/complicated treatment were referred to the college, where they will be given free treatment. Nearly all the school children who attended school on that day and 150 public were benefitted by this program.

**AWARENESS ON SMOKING/SMOKELESS TOBACCO**

**Dr.Kiran Iyer, M.D.S.**, Reader, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital had delivered a speech on awareness on using tobacco products to the village public. His speech was mainly focused on the harmful effects of tobacco and the great harm caused by the second-hand smoke that is emitted from smoking it. Few videos were also played in a LCD screen to educate the participants audio-visually.

**24.01.2019, THURSDAY**

**AWARENESS RALLY ON TOBACCO FREE ENVIRONMENT**

The rally was organized by the NSS volunteers on Tobacco free environment. Nearly 100 NSS volunteers actively participated in the rally. The rally started from Ragas dental college and hospital, which was flagged by The Principal, **Prof.Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan, M.D.S.**, and it, went through the streets of the village and ended back in the college covering nearly 3kms of distance. The volunteers were raising slogans which highlighted the hazards of tobacco and second hand smoking. Hoardings which emphasize the harmful effects of tobacco had been used and pamphlets depicting the same were also distributed to the public all through the rally.

**AWARENESS ON ROLE OF WOMEN IN SOCIETY**

**Dr.Aparna, M.D.S.**, Reader, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital delivered a message regarding women involvement in lifting the society towards achievements, targets, aims of future India, here society represents the young volunteers who are said to be the back bone of the country. Her speech insisted every woman knowingly or unknowingly help this field as She is the representative of a family, community, society, country in different roles. She also added about the different roles of women in our country in areas like schools and colleges, sports, science, navy, army and health care institutions.



**25.01.2019, FRIDAY**

**AWARENESS ON ORAL CANCER**

Dr.P.D.Madan Kumar, M.D.S., Prof. & Head, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital, delivered a special message on oral cancer about signs and symptoms, regions and stages of cancer, types including treatment and its preventive measures. He also explained about both the smoking and smokeless forms of tobacco available which creates hazards to health and primary care for oral cancer. Nearly 100 people were benefitted by this program.

**TOBACCO CESSATION PROGRAM**

On the day of dental camp, nearly 30 village people who were found to be current smokers were identified and were referred to the smoking cessation clinic available at the Ragas dental college & hospital. Dr.Iyyapparaja, M.D.S., Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital, had a 2 hour live interaction with those participants. His delivery address focused on how to make quit the tobacco by the participants. Their level of dependency was analyzed scientifically and depending on that, the treatment modalities were prescribed to them. There will be a 6 month follow up for those participants to analyze further their level of tobacco dependency and their quit rate.

**26.01.2019, SATURDAY**

**REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION**

On the day, prior to the commencement of camp, the village people were gathered to celebrate the Republic day at the government public union middle school campus. The school students, public, school staffs, along with NSS volunteers took part in the flag hoisting ceremony. After the ceremony, sports events like running race, long jump and fun activities like sack race, dance competition were conducted among the school children.

**AWARENESS ON ROAD SAFETY**

Dr.Naveenraj, M.D.S., Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital, delivered a speech emphasizing the importance of road safety measures. The focus group of this program were the youth boys, however the general public too attended and nearly 100 participants actively participated the program. His speech highlighted on importance that people are aware what evidence-based actions can be taken to prevent road traffic injuries among youth. His speech strongly insisted on the use of helmet for 2 wheeler drivers and use of seat belts for 4 wheeler drivers and abides by the driving speed limit of the area.

**28.01.2019, MONDAY**

**AWARENESS OF WATER SANITATION & HAND YGIENE**

Dr.Menaka, M.D.S., Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Periodontics, Ragas Dental College & Hospital, delivered a speech highlighting the importance of consuming clean and hygienic water and importance of hand hygiene and how its been done. The speech was given to the women in the village and there was a active participation. Her speech highlighted the useful effects of consuming clean water, ways of purification of water, etc.



**TREE SAPLINGS PLANTING**


