## NSS REGULAR CAMP REPORT 2017-2018

### 7<sup>th</sup> April' 2017

World health day, celebrated on 7<sup>th</sup> April every year to mark the anniversary of the founding of the World Health Organization, provides us with a unique opportunity to mobilize action around a specific health topic of concern to people. The theme of 2017 World Health Day campaign is Depression; let's talk.

Every year World Health Day will be celebrated at the college campus. "The theme and slogan of World Health Day 2017 is "Depression; let's talk". Prof Dr PD Madankumar, MDS, Head, Dept of Public Health Dentistry delivered a key note lecture to the under-graduate and post-graduate students highlighting the theme of the year.

### 31<sup>st</sup> May' 2017

On World No Tobacco Day 2017, WHO is highlighting how tobacco threatens the development of nations worldwide, and is calling on governments to implement strong tobacco control measures. These include banning marketing and advertising of tobacco, promoting plain packaging of tobacco products, raising excise taxes, and making indoor public places and work places smoke-free.

Every year May 31<sup>st</sup> is been celebrated as World No Tobacco Day. The theme of World No Tobacco Day 2017 is "Beating tobacco for health, prosperity, the environment and national development". A rally was organized, participated by NSS volunteers in Kanathur village highlighted the awareness on the negative impact that tobacco has on people's health, from cancer to chronic respiratory disease. Around 100 NSS participants actively participated and distributed pamphlets depicting the ill effects of tobacco.

### 5<sup>th</sup> June' 2017

The theme for World environmental day-2017 is 'Connecting People with Nature'. The theme highlighted the importance of natural systems and a clean environment to humanity, and encouraged people to appreciate those benefits 'first hand' including the 'beauty and diversity of the natural world that surrounds and sustains us'. A key note lecture by Dr Menaka, MDS, Reader, Dept of Periodontology from our institution, was arranged on highlighting the theme for the students to increase the awareness on



nature conservation. Every year environment day is celebrated on 5<sup>th</sup> June to spread awareness, to encourage people to take action and to protect the environment.

#### **17<sup>th</sup> July' 2017**

Career guidance program was organized in the college for the students doing internship. Dr.Aparna M.D.S., Reader, Dept of Public Health Dentistry of our institution delivered a speech which emphasized the importance of the topic. The programme developed individual's competencies in self knowledge, educational and occupational exploration, and career planning.

#### **15<sup>th</sup> August' 2017**

Independence day was celebrated by hoisting our National Flag by Prof Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan, M.D.S., Principal of our institute.

#### **5<sup>th</sup> September' 2017**

Gandhi jayanthi celebrations. Oral health screening and treatment camps were conducted in government school children around our institute to increase the awareness about oral health and oral hygiene. More than 100 children were benefitted by the program.

Free dental treatment camp was conducted by our institute in Pattipulam village. Dental screening, extraction, restoration and scaling treatments were done. Nearly 120 people were benefitted by the camp.

#### **29<sup>th</sup> December' 2017**

Dental screening and free treatment camp was conducted by the institute in Manjampakkam. The target population was truck/lorry drivers, however general public too benefitted by the camp. The main focus is on creating the awareness regarding oral cancer. Nearly 80 people were benefitted by the camp.

We conducted dental screening and dental treatment camp at Kovalam government high school along with NSS special camp conducted by Jaya engineering college.


06<sup>th</sup> March' 2018

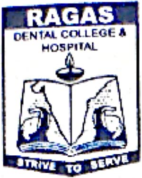

## NSS SPECIAL CAMP REPORT 2017-2018

**THEME: ROAD SAFETY**

**DATE: 07.01.2018 – 13.01.2018**

**VENUE: PATTIPULAM**

The NSS unit of Ragas Dental College & Hospital, along with The Jaya trust management and The Principal, Ragas Dental College & Hospital conducted a special camp for a period of 7 days from 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2019 to 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 in Kanathur Village, Kanchipuram.

The program was conducted under the guidance of **Prof.Kanagaraj**, Chairman, Jaya group of Institutions, **Prof.Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan, M.D.S.**, Principal, Ragas Dental College & Hospital and **Dr.P.D.Madan Kumar, M.D.S.**, Prof. & Head, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital.

**Prof.Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan, M.D.S.**, Principal, Ragas Dental College & Hospital inaugurated the program and **Mr.R.Rajaraman, M.A., M.Ed.**, Headmaster of the panchayat union primary school presided over the function.

Inaugural speech was delivered by **Prof.Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan, M.D.S.**, Principal, Ragas Dental College & Hospital. His speech motivated and stimulated the NSS volunteers about communication and social interaction towards the public, to gather information about the social issues among the community members.

Presidential address was given by **Dr.P.D.Madan Kumar, M.D.S.**, Prof. & Head, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital. The speech delivered by him to the NSS volunteers highlighted about their role and importance in conducting such special camps in the village for the betterment of the locals and the school children.

The chief guest **Mr.S.Subramaniam**, being a local person and past panchayat union chairman of the village, was so happy for selecting their village to be a part of such a useful community program. This campaign was useful for all the community members in aspects of medical/dental camps, healthy talk forums, etc.

The headmistress of the school **Mr.R.Rajaraman, M.A., M.Ed.**, appreciated about the use of school health program and dental camp among school children and for the village people.

The NSS volunteers of the Ragas Dental College & Hospital organized a skit play on "Road safety- need of the hour" which insists the proper and mandatory use of helmets and wearing seat belts while driving, following road traffic rules and obeying the signals. Nearly 150 public were involved in this program.

The day ended with the scavenging of the village and school premises and pamphlets were issued related to the theme and activities to be performed by the NSS volunteers in the forthcoming days.





**08.01.2018, MONDAY**

**GENERAL MEDICINE CAMP**

The medical camp was conducted by the Ragas general hospital which is situated in the premises of Ragas dental college & hospital. Free medical checkup was done to the public for various ailments including hypertension, diabetes mellitus, anemia, gastritis, vomiting, abdominal pain. The NSS volunteers actively participated in the program by checking blood pressure, temperature and weight of the participants. Nearly 100 people were benefitted by this medical camp.

**09.01.2018, TUESDAY**

**DENTAL CAMP**

The dental camp was conducted on 09<sup>th</sup> January, 2018 which was a screening and treatment program. Along with NSS volunteers, 50 students who were on their internship, also actively participated in the program. The camp was conducted in the school premises. All the school children and the village public who attended the camp were screened for any dental problems. After the initial screening, those who were in need of dental treatment were identified and treatments like simple extraction, scaling, restoration were done. Those who are need of any kind of advanced/complicated treatment were referred to the college, where they will be given free treatment. Nearly all the school children who attended school on that day and 150 public were benefitted by this program.

**10.01.2018, WEDNESDAY**

**AWARENESS RALLY ON TOBACCO FREE ENVIRONMENT**

The rally was organized by the NSS volunteers on Tobacco free environment. Nearly 75 NSS volunteers actively participated in the rally. The rally started from Ragas dental college and hospital, which was flagged by The Principal, **Prof.Dr.N.S.Azhagarasan, M.D.S.**, and it, went through the streets of the village and ended back in the college covering nearly 3kms of distance. The volunteers were raising slogans which highlighted the hazards of tobacco and second hand smoking. Hoardings which emphasize the harmful effects of tobacco had been used and pamphlets depicting the same were also distributed to the public all through the rally.

**AWARENESS ON SMOKING/SMOKELESS TOBACCO**

**Dr.Iyapparajar, M.D.S.**, Reader, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital had delivered a speech on awareness on using tobacco products to the village public. His speech was mainly focused on the harmful effects of tobacco and the great harm caused by the second-hand smoke that is emitted from smoking it. Few videos were also played in a LCD screen to educate the participants audio-visually.

**11.01.2018, THURSDAY**

**AWARENESS ON ORAL CANCER**

**Dr.P.D.Madan Kumar, M.D.S.**, Prof. & Head, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital, delivered a special message on oral cancer about signs and symptoms, regions and stages of cancer, types including treatment and its preventive measures. He also explained about both the smoking and smokeless forms of tobacco available which creates hazards to health and primary care for oral cancer. Nearly 100 people were benefitted by this program.

**TOBACCO CESSATION PROGRAM**

On the day of dental camp, nearly 30 village people who were found to be current smokers were identified and were referred to the smoking cessation clinic available at the Ragas dental college & hospital. **Dr.Aparna, M.D.S.**, Reader, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Ragas Dental College & Hospital, had a 2 hour live interaction with those participants. His delivery address focused on how to





make quit the tobacco by the participants. Their level of dependency was analyzed scientifically and depending on that, the treatment modalities were prescribed to them. There will be a 6 month follow up for those participants to analyze further their level of tobacco dependency and their quit rate.

**12.01.2018, FRIDAY**

**AWARENESS ON ROLE OF WOMEN IN SOCIETY**

**Dr.Menaka, M.D.S.**, Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Periodontics, Ragas Dental College & Hospital delivered a message regarding women involvement in lifting the society towards achievements, targets, aims of future India, here society represents the young volunteers who are said to be the back bone of the country. Her speech insisted every woman knowingly or unknowingly help this field as She is the representative of a family, community, society, country in different roles. She also added about the different roles of women in our country in areas like schools and colleges, sports, science, navy, army and health care institutions.


**AWARENESS ON ROAD SAFETY**
